



# Floral Park-Bellerose UFSD 2021-2022 Update

**We are actively planning for the upcoming 2021-2022 school year, and at this time, based on all relevant guidance and regulations, we currently plan to begin the school year with all students learning in person. It is important to note that guidance and regulations from both the New York State Department of Health (NYDOH) and New York State Education Department (NYSED) are subject to change, and we will be updating this plan, accordingly.**

## Instruction

- All in-person students returned to 5 days per week on October 13
- All in-person students returned to a full day on April 6
- Need for a remote program for 21-22 School Year will be determined based on the Governor’s regulations and the NYSDOH guidelines
- Clubs, Music Program, Departmentalization (5th and 6th) and School Life Plus will be determined based on the Governor’s regulations and the NYSDOH guidelines
- Specials will return to regular schedules unless otherwise impacted by the Governor’s regulations and the NYSDOH guidelines
- An after school tutoring program is being investigated for the 21-22 School Year



## Health and Safety

- PPE equipment will continue to be provided as per the Governor’s regulations and the NYSDOH guidelines
- Barriers and desk distance will be based on CDC and NYSDOH guidelines
- Face masks will be determined by CDC and NYSDOH guidelines
- Masks are no longer required outdoors
- Cafeteria usage will be based on CDC guidelines and NYSDOH guidelines
- Building sanitizing protocols will remain in place
- “Take Action” will continue as required
- Students presenting with any Covid-19 symptoms should remain at home
- Contact tracing will continue based on CDC and NYSDOH Guidelines
- Covid-19, quarantining and isolating protocols will be based on CDC and DOH guidelines
- Any person who displays Covid-19 symptoms in school will be immediately separated and brought to an isolation area
- Grab and Go breakfast will continue
- Bus capacity will be based on CDC and NYSDOH guidelines
- Play structures will remain open unless otherwise impacted by NYSDOH and CDC guidelines



## Social Emotional Learning

- On-going communication between teachers and mental health staff
- Newsletter to share topics and strategies
- Utilizing Multi-Tier System of Support (MTSS)
- Provide resources to families
- On-going professional development and training
- Surveys to gauge mental health status
- Promote initiatives such as family night, investigate new clubs and continue with existing clubs and look to continue a summer enrichment program



## Technology

- District will continue to implement 1:1 devices for every student
- Hot spots are available to students who do not have access to high-speed internet
- A new filtering system has been purchased that allows for filtering of devices at home
- New APPs will continue to be investigated to facilitate teaching and learning
- Teachers were given new 11-inch iPad Pros and new 13-inch Mac Book Pros
- Apple TVs have been installed in grades Pre-K to 2
- Professional development is ongoing
